Masking Policy Changes for the CMU Community Changes Take Effect This Week


President Davies asked faculty leadership, students, and staff to provide recommendations about possible changes to the masking policies in place around Covid and campus-wide mandates. On Friday, March 18, President Davies sent out an email announcing the changes to the campus masking policy. See this link for the current policy: <u>CMU Health and Wellness page</u>.

Some things to note:

- Testing will continue and will be required for the unvaccinated.
- Masks are required in indoor instructional spaces, optional elsewhere (hallways, bathrooms, workspaces*)
- Masking in faculty offices will be up to the faculty.
- Masks should be made available across campus soon.

For our FA members, our union bargained for the <u>CMUFA Memorandum</u> of Agreement in the Fall Semester, 2021. The agreement allows for members of the bargaining unit to request non-ADA accommodations, using the <u>Non-ADA Accommodation Request Form</u>, for Covid-related issues. If you are uncomfortable being in shared spaces (halls, bathrooms, etc.) with unmasked people because you or people you care for are immune-vulnerable, consider submitting a request to your chair. This agreement is in place for the whole of the semester- use it if you need it, friends!

VERIFI1 Update:

While it brings us no pleasure to report this update on the circumstances around the demand for documents from **Verifi1** (<u>Link to</u> <u>Verifi1 Login</u>), we report that there are no contractual conflicts with the request from CMU. We also asked about a possible extension to the **April 8** deadline, but were informed that, due to CMU's benefit enrollment window/period, the deadline to submit documents would have to remain as indicated.

We have also received many questions about the submission of official documents not recorded in the preferred language. There is a phone number provided by the Verifi1 (855-486-2472 between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. ET Monday-Friday). It is advised that if the documents that qualify for dependent verification are not recorded in the preferred language, to call the number above for further instructions.

Please plan to have requested documentation into the system by **April 8, 2022**.
